## APPLYING FOR CLEARANCES

According to the Department of Human Services - Clearances are required for an employee or unpaid volunteer at a minimum of every 60 months from the date of the oldest clearance. Clearances may be required more frequently based on licensure or employer requirements.

  (required for all employees and some volunteers)

For the FBI Clearance you will need a service code: Use 1KG738

## **MANDATED REPORTER TRAINING - every 5 years**

This training is for all volunteers and employees who work with children/youth weekly and/or overnight.

This training is **MANDATED** for all employees, including ministers, RECOMMENDED for volunteers.

Most volunteers are <u>mandated</u> (required) to report child abuse under the new law. Training will:

- 1) define mandated reporters vs. permissive reporters (those who choose to report)
- 2) teach procedure for reporting suspected child abuse
